The aim of this policy is to ensure that the high standard of education being provided to Merstham Primary School pupils is sustained during any COVID related absences or temporary closures during the academic year 2020 - 2021. The school recognises that it is essential to take a flexible approach and that our remote learning provision is able to respond to the changeable needs of pupils, parents and staff, as well as mindful of the additional barriers we are all facing due to the global pandemic.
