**Supervisory Provision for Vulnerable Children and Children of Key Workers:
Monday 20th April - Friday 24th April**

Parents and carers will be aware that the school continues to provide basic supervisory care for a limited number of children - children who are vulnerable and children whose parents are critical to the COVID -19 response and cannot be safely cared for at home.

It remains government guidance that every child who can be safely cared for at home, should be. Use of school provision should be seen as a last resort.

Where families wish to make use of this provision next week (Monday 20th April - Friday 24th April) we ask that you [complete this form](#).

In order to limit childcare to both a manageable level and to those that genuinely need it and are critical to the COVID-19 response, we are asking parents to provide proof of eligibility. We would be grateful if parents who intend to use our provision forward such proof to info@mersthamprimaryschool.org
